## 2019 Scholarship Instructions and Checklist

Please follow these instructions *carefully*. **Only COMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL BE CONSIDERED.**

Applications are due in the AHS Counseling Center by **Noon on March 29, 2019.**

**(Use the checklist to verify that the required documents are included in your application)**

Please submit the following **REQUIRED** documents (#s 1-6 below) with your application:

- 1. **Personal Statement.** We want to get to know who you are, what makes you unique, and what your hopes and dreams are. This could include, but is not limited to how you've overcome challenges, or extenuating financial/family circumstances; your participation in sports and extra-curricular activities; previous work experience, be it babysitting or refereeing with Parks and Rec.; any other unique pieces of **YOUR STORY**.
- 2. **Résumé** that includes as many of the following as applicable:  
School Activities; Awards; Community Involvement; Volunteer Activities; Employment History
- 3. **Transcript(s)**, including 2018-2019 1<sup>st</sup> semester grades. Transcripts must be stamped by the registrar, but should NOT be sealed. *Please do not submit transcripts in an envelope.*
- 4. **SAT and/or ACT score reports *OR*** a copy of report(s) stamped by the registrar.  
*(Required for graduating seniors only. SAT/ACT scores are optional for current college students.)*
- 5. **Student Aid Report:** Page 1 (**only**) of the 2019-2020 Student Aid Report (SAR) from FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) which shows your EFC.
- 6. Completed Application form clipped to the front of the application packet.

**OPTIONAL Information:**

- Recommendations:** You may include up to two (2) recommendations from a teacher, coach, employer, club advisor, pastor, etc. Recommendations on letterhead are preferred.
- Supporting Information Statement:** Is there anything else we should know? You may attach a one page supporting information statement to help us to know you and your circumstances better, or to explain any omitted documents. *Note: This document is not required.* In the past, students have used this option to explain extenuating family or financial circumstances, reasons for omitted documents (some students with plans to attend community college, for example, may not have SAT scores), etc.

**Please do NOT:**

- Submit your application in any type of binder or folder
- Include photos, copies of awards or materials not specifically requested in the application  
(no part of the application will be returned)

**All scholarships awarded through the Anacortes Schools Foundation are sent directly to the school chosen by the award recipient. The funds can be used for qualified education expenses as defined by the IRS for tax-free scholarships. These expenses include tuition, required fees, and course related expenses (fees, books, & supplies), but exclude room & board and travel. (See IRS Publication 970 for more detail.)**
